

FARM AND RANCH WATER INFRASTRUCTURE PROGRAM

FRWIP is designed to support the development of secure and sustainable water sources and provides producers with a rebate for dugout, pipeline, and well projects that meet program criteria.

Funding: 50% of eligible costs to a maximum of \$50,000 over the 5-year program term

The following supporting infrastructure is eligible when done in conjunction with a new project (well, dugout, or pipeline):

- Permanently installed water storage tanks (minimum 1000 US gallons/3700 litres) to a maximum rebate of \$2500.
- All-in-one solar powered water pumping system (one solar system to a maximum rebate of \$5000 per project).
- Pump related upgrades and miscellaneous plumbing materials to a maximum payment of \$2,500 per eligible project (electric pump and controller, pressure system, and fittings and connectors).
- Trenching and pipe from well or dugout to pressure system and to the water distribution point.

Eligibility:

- Earn a minimum of \$50,000 of gross farm income in Saskatchewan.
- Producers who own, lease or rent property where livestock and poultry are grown, bred, kept, raised, displayed, assembled or disposed of require a Saskatchewan Premises Identification.
- Projects on land not owned by the applicant will require written authorization from the land owner.
