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**Terms & Conditions:**

1. Any person or organization wishing to remove trees, brush rocks &/or debris within the municipal right-of-way shall first obtain prior approval from Council prior to undertaking the proposed works.
2. The Municipality may compensate the applicant, up to a maximum of \$500.00 per ½ mile, if it can be demonstrated that the works benefits both parties and prior approval from council has been obtained.
3. The person or organization performing the works shall be responsible to dispose of any trees, brush, rocks &/or debris removed from municipal right of way.
4. The right-of-way must be left in a safe and respectable manner without any blockage of trees, brush, rocks or debris.
5. If the trees, brush, rocks &/or debris is not disposed of in a safe & respectable manner, the RM maintains the right to clean up & dispose of the trees, brush, rocks &/or and all costs for the cleanup & disposal shall be the responsibility of the applicant.
6. The completion of any works done on the municipal right-of-way will be subject to inspection by the Municipal Foreman in order to be eligible for payment. Once the Foreman has granted approval of the works, payment will be made at the following council meeting of the Municipality.
7. It shall be the responsibility of the applicant to locate any buried cables or pipelines (includes all underground installations and survey monuments) prior to the work being initiated. The RM will not be responsible for any damages to buried cables or pipelines.
8. Permission for brush removal does not grant permission for crop production or livestock fencing on road allowances.
9. Upon approval, this permit will be in good standing for ninety (90) days and does not grant any future approval, nor approval for legal land locations not pertaining to this form.
10. The applicant certifies that all information provided is correct. The applicant, upon signing agrees to all terms and conditions as provided on this form and any conditions that may rise upon approval of the application.


