The maximum allowable encroachment into the ER beyond the property boundary shall be no more than 3 metres. The applicant is solely responsible for all design, safety, and workmanship aspects associated with this approval and all work must be completed in accordance with the regulations of the Water Security Agency's Aquatic Habitat Protection Permit.
