

CUSTOM WORK AGREEMENT – RM of SPIRITWOOD NO. 496

This Custom Work Agreement made the _____ day of _____, 20_____

BETWEEN

The Rural Municipality of Spiritwood No. 496 (hereinafter referred to as “the Municipality”)

AND

(hereinafter referred to as the “Grantor”)

WHEREAS, the Grantor, being the registered owner of the following land, situate in the Province of Saskatchewan and being described as:

WHEREAS, the Grantor desires the Municipality to provide custom work on the above described land as per the following instructions:

As per the terms & conditions described below:

1. The Grantor, doth hereby grant, convey and assign to the Municipality the right by its servants, employees, contractors, workmen or assigns to enter upon the above described land, for the purpose of providing the above custom work.
2. The Grantor hereby covenants and agrees that he/she at all times indemnify and save harmless the Municipality, it’s servants, agents and employees from and against all loss, damage or injury, however caused, to any person or property of any person, including the Grantor, at any time during the carrying out of this agreement on the above described land.
3. The Grantor will undertake to advise the municipality, by writing above, of the location of any items/objects which may be concealed or not be apparent upon a visual inspection of the property, including but not limited to wells, cables, personal items, survey monuments or underground lines, etc.
4. Should the Grantor fail to advise the municipality by written instruction, the Grantor agrees to compensate the municipality for any resulting damage caused by the concealed item or object.
5. The Grantor agrees to pay the Municipality the custom work rates in force on the date of this agreement, and set by the Council of the Rural Municipality of Spiritwood No. 496.
