

Building Relocation Permit Application Requirements

Permits are required when a building is being relocated within a property, relocated to a new property within the R.M. or relocated outside of the municipality.

Building Relocation

1. A Building Permit will be required for all building relocations.
2. The R.M. may request the building be inspected before it is moved, indicating whether or not the structure is suitable to be relocated.
3. Pre-move inspections are not required for the placement of **new** Ready-to-Move Home (RTM) or mobile homes. Relocated RTM's are subject to all of the requirements contained herein.
4. If the building is suitable to be relocated, a completed building permit application form shall be submitted. For residential building permit requirements,
5. Upon review of the submitted plans, a Building Permit may be issued subject to addressing any remedial measures identified in the plan review.
6. After the permits have been issued for the relocation of the building, as well as the construction of the foundation, the applicant is responsible for contacting the building official (Construction Code Authority) to arrange for all required inspections.
